

VFW Golf League

Rules and Scoring

Existing Rules:

- Matches to start at scheduled time – Team can't get bonus point if starting with one golfer.
- 2 no-shows by individual golfer will result in removal from league in next year. This includes position rounds
- 70% of matches need played to have league play count. This is not required on position round night in bad weather.
- Lost balls and Out of bounds are played as a lateral hazard. Play ball from rough at approx. area where ball entered OB or hazard. Ball may also be replayed from previous spot. One stroke penalty applies.
- Man-made drainage ditches are played as a free drop
- When reaching your maximum score on a hole, pick up.
- If all golfers max out on a hole, hole is halved, move to next tee.
- Total points per match is 10. 1 pt. per hole plus 1 pt. for best net total of partners combined score.
- Forfeit is worth 7 pts.
- Maximum handicap is 14
- Seniors 60 and over may use gold tees. Seniors 75 and older may use red tees. Do not switch tee choice after start of league.

Local Rules:

- Ball in waste area on #16 past trees is free lift above cart path
- Ball may be moved one club length, except in natural woods.

Scoring:

Players with no handicap: League scorer will calculate handicap and score match when complete. Max. score for new players is 4 over par hole.

Maximum score used to calculate handicap is double bogey.

Maximum score used for bonus point is double bogey plus the number of strokes player gets on each particular hole.

(Ex. – Player getting one stroke on a par four – max. score is a 7)

Lowest net score of partners wins the bonus point.

(Ex. – 2 partners, both 5 handicaps shoot 40. Their team net is 70
40 plus 40 (80) minus 10 = 70)

If unsure of scoring, just write down actual score, up to maximum allowed.

Strokes per hole is calculated by handicap.

A 9 handicap gets 1 stroke per hole.

An 11 handicap gets 1 stroke per hole, plus one extra on 2 hardest holes.

A 5 handicap gets strokes on the five hardest holes.

Max. scores per hole based on handicap:

Players with no strokes – Double bogey

Players with one stroke – Triple bogey

Players with two strokes – Quad. bogey
